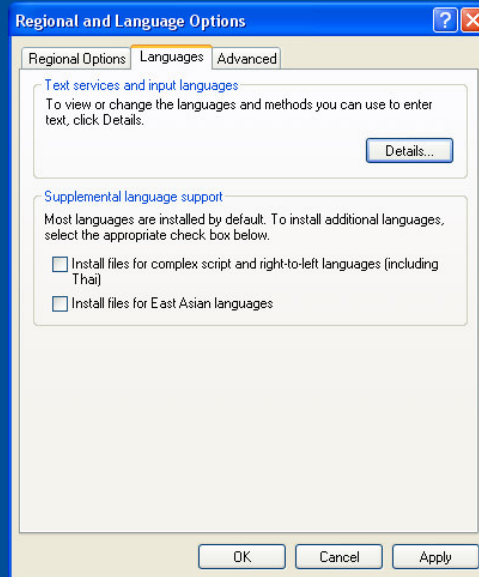


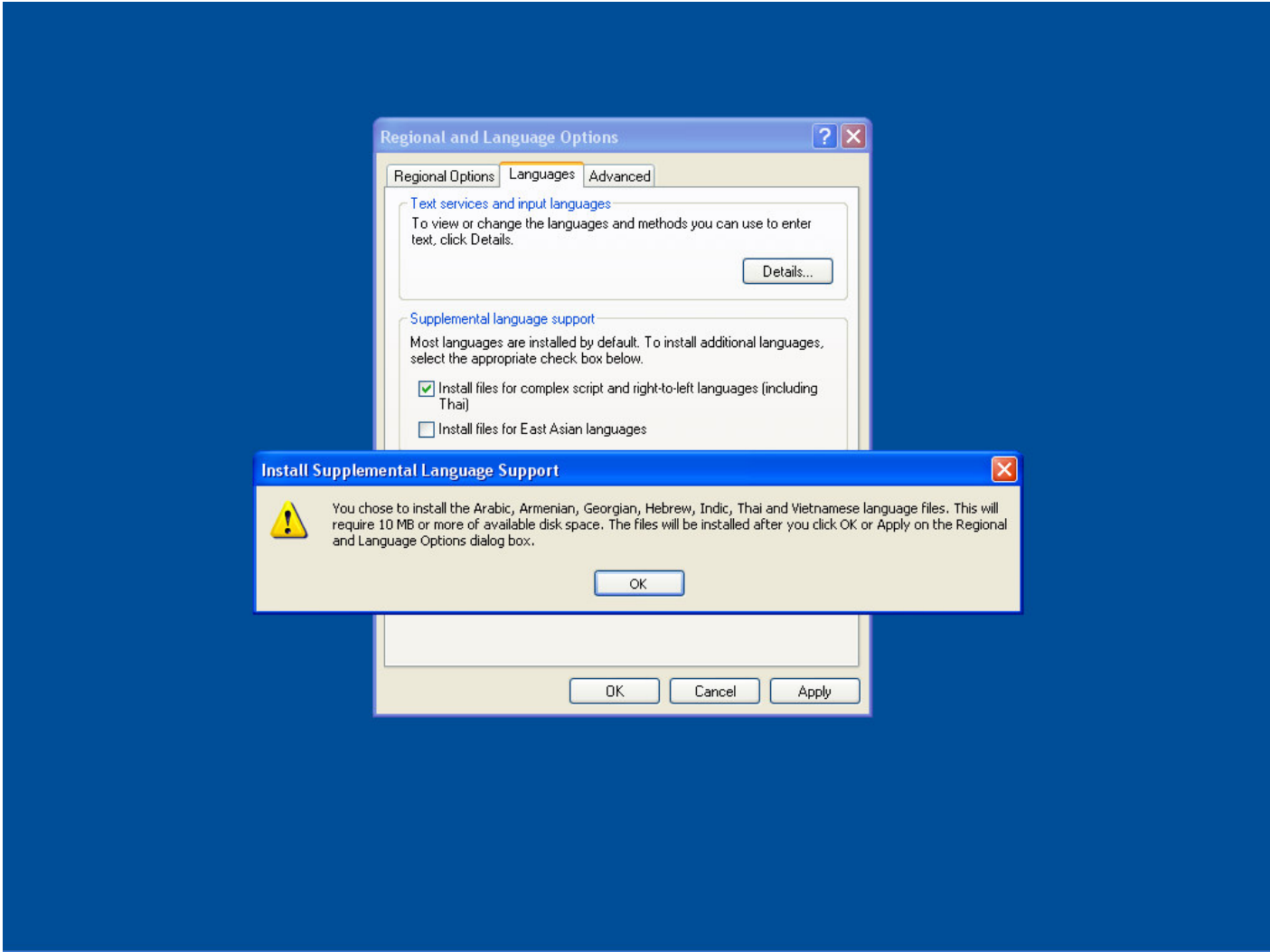
## How to Install Unicode Fonts - Windows XP

**Step-1:** Go to Start Button -> Setting -> Control Panel.

**Step-2:** Select 'Regional and Language Option', then click on 'Language' Tab option as below:



**Step-3:** Click on first Check Box and check it, then a message box like 'Install Supplement Language Support' appears as below, click 'OK' button.



**Step-4:** After clicking on Apply button, it asks for Windows-XP CD, then enter CD into CD-Drive and press OK button. It copies the required supporting fonts from CD to your Computer's Hard Disk and then restart the Computer to take effect of these fonts.

In case if Windows-XP CD is unavailable, then an alternate option is, if there exists a 'i386' folder in any of your Hard Drive C or D....., then you select this folder in place of XP-CD then click on OK button without inserting any CD.
